

# INTERSTATE PASSPORT

The Interstate Passport® at TMCC (<http://interstate-passport.wiche.edu/public/?publicprofile&campus=3361&cname=Truckee%20Meadows%20Community%20College>) is awarded to students who have achieved lower-division general education learning outcomes in a set of approved courses that are recognized by all other colleges and universities participating in the Interstate Passport Network (<http://interstatepassport.wiche.edu/institute/>). Students must earn a grade of C (not C-) or higher in each of these approved courses to receive a Passport. Students earning the Passport at TMCC may transfer their general education as a block instead of course by course to any school that is also a Passport Network Member (<http://interstatepassport.wiche.edu/institute/>). This streamlined transfer of general education saves students time and money by not having to repeat general education requirements when they transfer to another Passport institution.
